

**Series: 7 Habits of a Disciple**  
**Message: The *Sanctified* Life**  
**Text: Luke 6:43-49 (AM 4/9/17)**

Every branch of the military has their own allegiance, but most would agree that Marines are a *little different*. “Once a Marine, always a Marine”. You can take a man out of the Marines but you can’t take the Marine out of the man. Many religions have *disciples*, but Jesus’ disciples are to be *different*. We’re to be *sanctified* or set apart from the world for God’s purposes. The greatest sermon ever preached was delivered by the greatest man to ever live - Jesus. In the summary of His Sermon on the Mount, Jesus *defines* for us the Disciple’s *Sanctified life*. The first 3 Habits of a disciple are – the *Surrendered; Supplicating;* and *Sanctified* life. Let’s explore the refreshingly radical *attributes* of the Sanctified life.

**1<sup>st</sup> A Disciple’s Distinction (43-45)** “Every tree is known by its own fruit...”  
*A sanctified life is fruitful*

**2<sup>nd</sup> A Disciple’s Decision (47)** “Whoever comes to Me...”  
*A sanctified life has been forgiven*

**3<sup>rd</sup> A Disciple’s Devotion (46)** “Do the things which I say...”  
*A sanctified life is a fully devoted Christ follower*

**4<sup>th</sup> A Disciple’s Dedication (48a)** “He is like a man building a house...”  
*A sanctified life is kingdom focused*

**5<sup>th</sup> A Disciple’s Discipline (48b)** “Who...laid the foundation on the Rock”  
*A sanctified life’s foundation is the Word*

**6<sup>th</sup> A Disciple’s Deliverance (48c)** “The (storm) beat...but could not shake it”  
*A sanctified life becomes a fortress in life’s storms*

**7<sup>th</sup> A Disciple’s Discovery (21)** “Blessed are you who hunger...shall be filled”  
*A sanctified life is fully satisfied*

**Application to our life:** Everyone is in search of *fulfillment*. Tragically, most are looking in all the *wrong* places – possessions, popularity, power, prestige, or the next party. Jesus reveals the true *pathway* to peace; the Sanctified life. Aren’t you ready to *build* a life that will *stand* the test of life’s storms and discover along the way the *fully satisfied* life?
